Lesson -7 Adjectives

1. What is an Adjective? Give examples.

Ans. A word that describes noun or pronoun is called an adjective.

Eg. A beautiful garden

A tall tree

I have ten fingers.

2. What is meant by adjectives of quality? Mention few qualities of an adjectives.

Ans. Adjectives that describes the kind or quality of nouns are called adjectives of quality.

The quality includes-

- a) Colour – a red rose
- b) Sounds- a shrill cry
- c) Shapes- a rectangular box
- d) Feelings- an angry man
- e) Nationality- an Indian lady

3. What are called adjectives of number? Give few examples.

Ans. The adjectives that tells us the number or rank of nouns are called adjectives of number.

Eg. I stood first in class

I have four apples

There are forty students in the classroom

4. What are degrees of comparison? What are the three forms of degrees of comparison?

Ans. Degrees of comparison refers to adjectives written in different forms to compare one, two or more nouns which are words describing persons, places and things.

The three forms of degrees of comparison are-

- a) The positive degree (tall)
- b) The comparative degree (taller)
- c) The superlative degree (tallest)
