Q.1. what is an adjective? Give examples.

Ans:- An adjective is a describing word. An adjective gives more information about a person place animal or thing.

Example:- juicy mango, tall building, smart girl, kind boy, etc.

Q.2. Define adjective of quality with examples.

Ans:- An adjective of quality describes the quality, colour, size, shape, taste, smell, sound, etc of a noun or pronoun.

Example:- I have a big red ball
I don't like loud music.

Q.3. Define adjective of quantity with examples.

Ans:- An adjective of quantity is used to describe the amount of a noun. An adjective of quantity mostly describes uncountable nouns.

Examples:- I need some sugar.
I have little water in the bottle.

Q.4. Define adjective of numbers with examples.

Ans:- An adjective of numbers are the adjectives used to denote number of nouns or pronouns including their position or place. An adjective of number is used with the countable nouns.

Examples:- He gave me five mangoes.
I was sitting in the third bench.

Q.5. How to make a perfect sentence when we use more than one adjective?
Explain with example.

Ans:- To make a perfect sentence, we should follow the following order:

Size → texture → colour → noun

Example:- I have long shiny red ribbon.
